“ILSAC GF-4” engine oil has been added as an option in the Information section.

Previous versions of this TSB should be discarded.

Introduction The correct engine oil viscosity and fill level are critical for the proper performance of the 1NZ-FXE engine installed in 2001 – 2007 model year Prius vehicles. Incorrect engine oil viscosity or improper fill level may result in a M.I.L. “ON” condition (most common Diagnostic Trouble Code [DTC] P3191, “Engine Does Not Start”).

Applicable Vehicles

- 2001 – 2007 model year **Prius** vehicles.

Information Ensure that the correct engine oil viscosity is used in the engine with the correct fill level quantity as described in the Owner’s Manual:

Engine Oil Quantity, with filter, qt. (L, Imp. qt.):	3.9 (3.7, 3.3)
Recommended Viscosity:	SAE 5W-30
Engine Oil Grade:	API grade SL “Energy-Conserving” OR ILSAC GF-4
