

Movie Quotes Game

Official Rules

1. The owner of the winning submittal will receive one (1) **\$25 electronic gift card to Amazon.com**. If the winning submittal is owned by a team, the individual team members must fight to the death. Or share, whatever floats your boat.
2. All submittals must be returned to Tony and Nicole before High Noon on Saturday. Results and answers will be disclosed Saturday Night Fever. If you answer all 88 and are convinced that they are all correct, you may submit your entry earlier (refer to Scoring).
3. Players are allowed to beg for and borrow answers from other players. Stealing is encouraged. Swapping and trading answers are allowed. Whether a player provides the true answer or lies to you is on their conscience. Whether you believe them is on yours.
4. Please refrain from using the internet to look up the answers.
5. In the event of a tie:
 - If all 88 quotes are correct, the earliest date/time-stamped submittal wins.
 - If multiple submittals contain the same number of correct answers, the winner will be chosen alphabetically by last name.
6. This list provides only some of the rules. The rest will be made up as the week progresses.

Scoring

1. There are 88 quotes. There is no weighting of quotes; no quote is more “valuable” than another. Each submittal will be scored from 0 – 88.
2. If you’re feeling Braveheart, you can submit your completed entry to Tony and/or Nicole at any time during the week. Once an entry is submitted, you can not get it back until Saturday Night Fever.

About the Quotes

1. These quotes were gathered and verified via IMDB.com, the Internet Movie Database.
2. Most films are American films. There are a few international films.
3. They might not be the most famous quotes of the movies they are from.
 - Most quotes are not the most famous lines of the movie. Most were chosen to provide some insight to the movie they are from. They might provide a one-line summary of the plot, refer to a main character, or reference an important part of the film.
 - They might be the spoken line directly before or immediately following famous lines. For example, Rhett Butler’s quote, “frankly my dear” is too obvious. However, he was responding to Scarlett’s question, “If you go, where shall I go? What shall I do?”
 - They might just be fun quotes. Some were picked because we feel certain people have probably seen the movie.
4. Most movies are famous, Oscar award-winning movies. Some are not. Some movies were chosen based on their impact on cinema, society, or for their importance at the time they were released. Some were selected because we happen to like them.

Hints

1. If properly enticed, Tony and Nicole might provide hints about individual quotes or feedback on your overall progress.
 - Nicole likes her martinis dirty with three olives.
 - Tony likes to win at Euchre.
