Major Audio Enhancements

- Satellite Radio now standard on JBL.
- Bluetooth version 2.0 streams music directly from device to headunit, even allowing internet radio from supported devices.




Major NAVI Enhancements

- Improvements to Point-of-Interest (POI) searching
 - Intuitive searching by name allows Wal-Mart, WalMart, In-N-Out, In and Out, etc.




- Simplified search by proximity points an arrow in the direction of POI to ease identifying "en route"



Major NAVI Enhancements (cont.)

- Streamlined destination flow should help reduce confusion and improve user success rate.



- Improvements to address and POI entry:
 - Street name readout will say name of street during voice guidance directions
 - Automatically completes entry when typing words
 - Entering a company name results in a local search based on current position
- PBAP allows paired phone to download entire contact list to vehicle and use voice to call by name (in NAV-equipped only)



- Ability to bypass voice prompt
- On-screen display options assist with menu command path and task completion
- Ability to select from four (4) previous destinations or five (5) call history entries while in motion
