

## Under Console Light

Disclaimer:

Use the contents of this document at your own risk.

Materials:

1. 5 volt frosted LED (any color). Can be purchased at RadioShack.
2. Appropriate sized load resistor. I can't remember which size resistor I got but used an online calculator to figure it out.
3. LED holder.
4. Wire and wiring tools.

Install:

I connected the positive side of the LED to the Head Unit dimmer trigger wire. The wire is energized when the parking or headlights are activated. It was in close proximity so I used that. Another option might be to tap into the Climate Control wiring.

I drilled a hole for the light and the LED just to the side of the seam of the console from inside the console (see other documents for disassembly). I placed it just where the console underside starts heading downward such that the LED light would shine back towards the rear of the console area. Depends on what you want covered by the light.

I used a frosted LED so the light would be dispersed rather than a concentrated beam.
