<sup>3</sup> BMW has traditionally chosen to include sales of the 4-Series within figures for the 3-Series, presumably for year-over-year consistency's sake, while also combining the 1-Series and 2-Series. Now, for July, we have a 3-Series/4-Series breakdown. (Hyundai does the same with the Genesis and Genesis Coupe.)

Total 3-Series/4-Series sales: up 5.0% to 13,103 in August; up 12% to 91,711 YTD.

Sales data for brands such as Aston Martin, Ferrari, Lamborghini, Lotus, Rolls-Royce etc. are unfortunately not broken down by model. ANDC estimates say sales for those brands in the first eight months of 2015 were 680, 1416, 504, 100, and 760, respectively. Tesla, unfortunately, doesn't release model-specific monthly U.S. sales data, but *Automotive News* now issues estimates for the brand, and those estimates say Tesla sold 1700 cars in August; 13,600 YTD. [HybridCars.com](#) estimates 1600 August Model S sales; 15,300 YTD.
